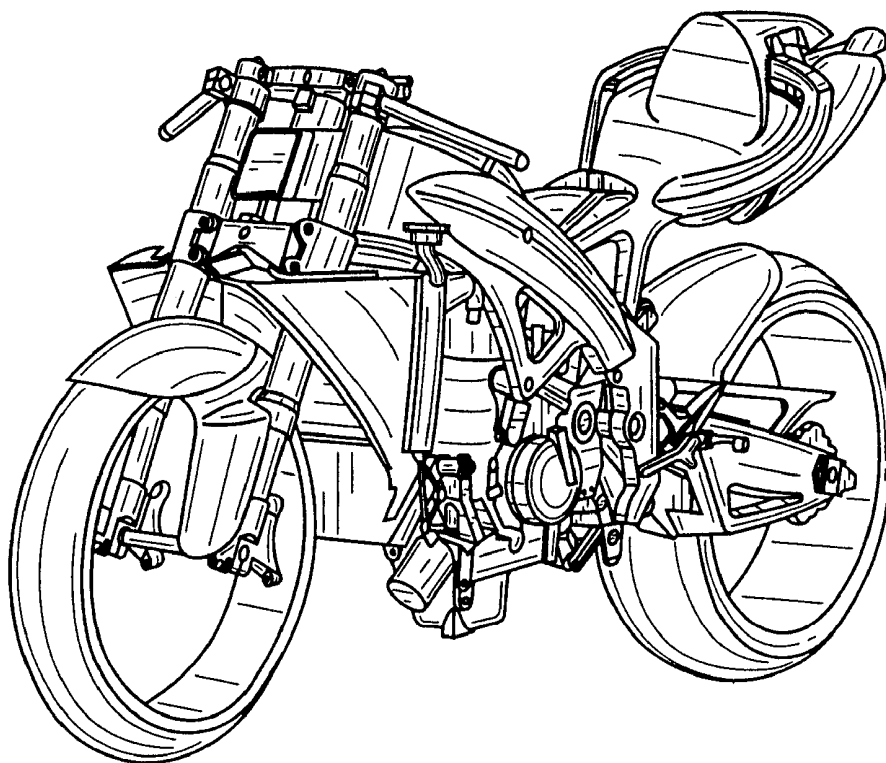
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of one side of a motoring
bike showing an embodiment of our new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the opposite side thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

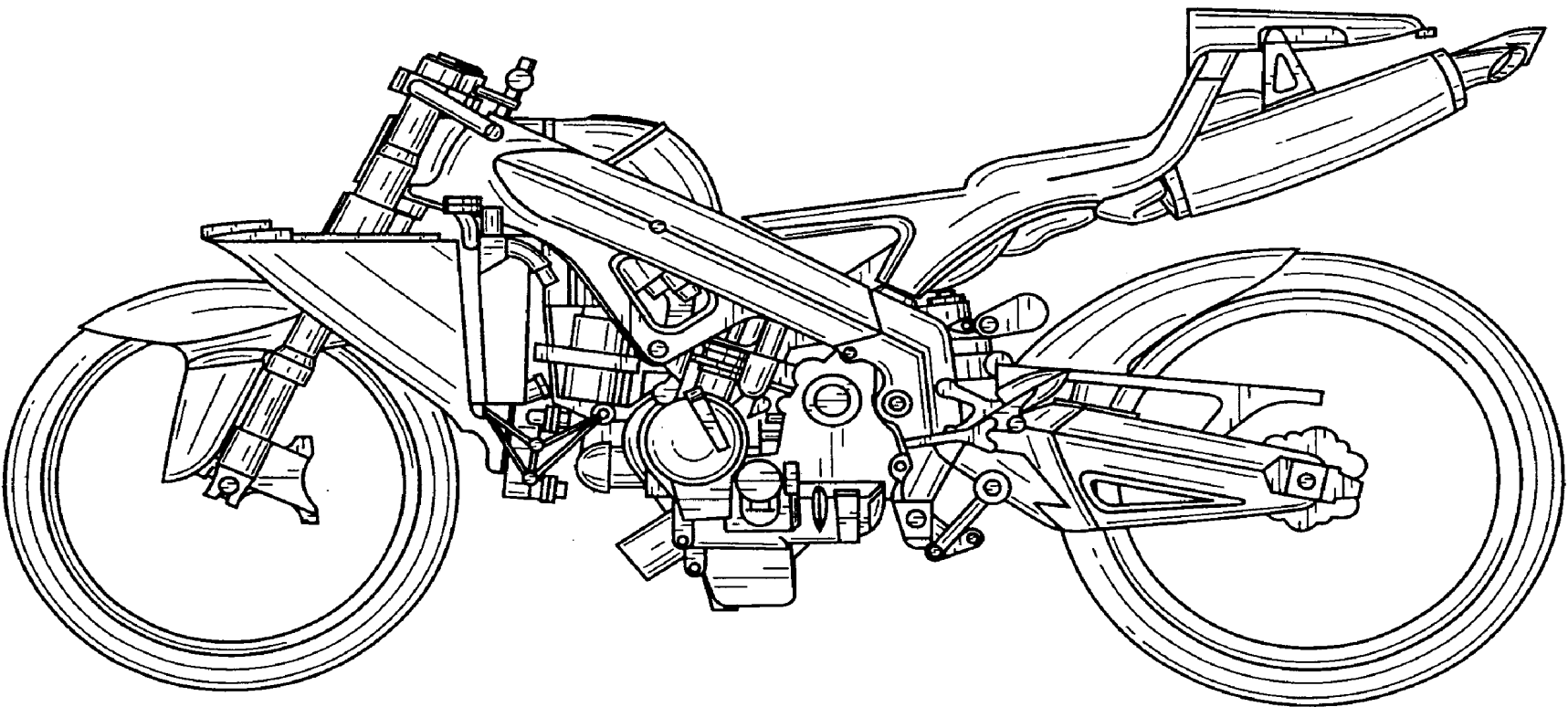

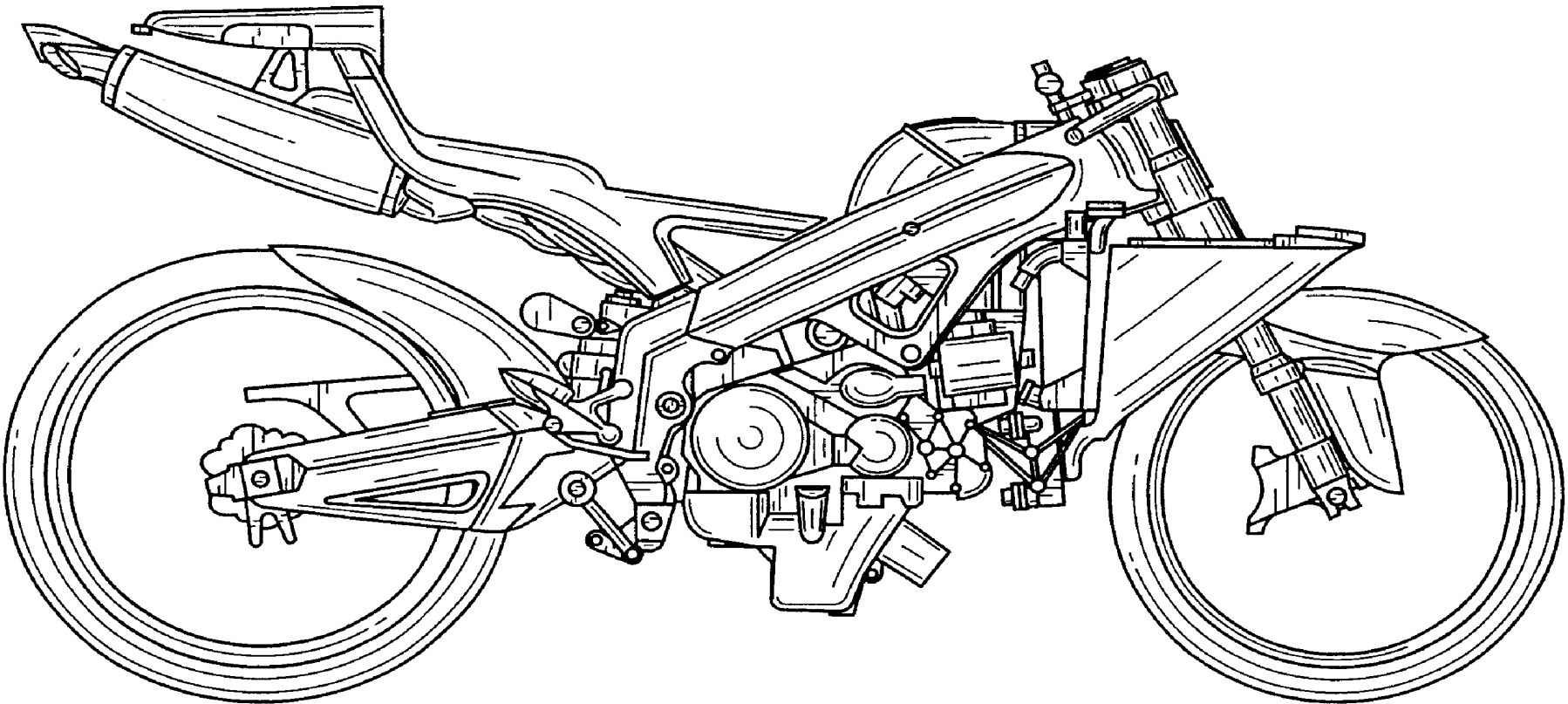

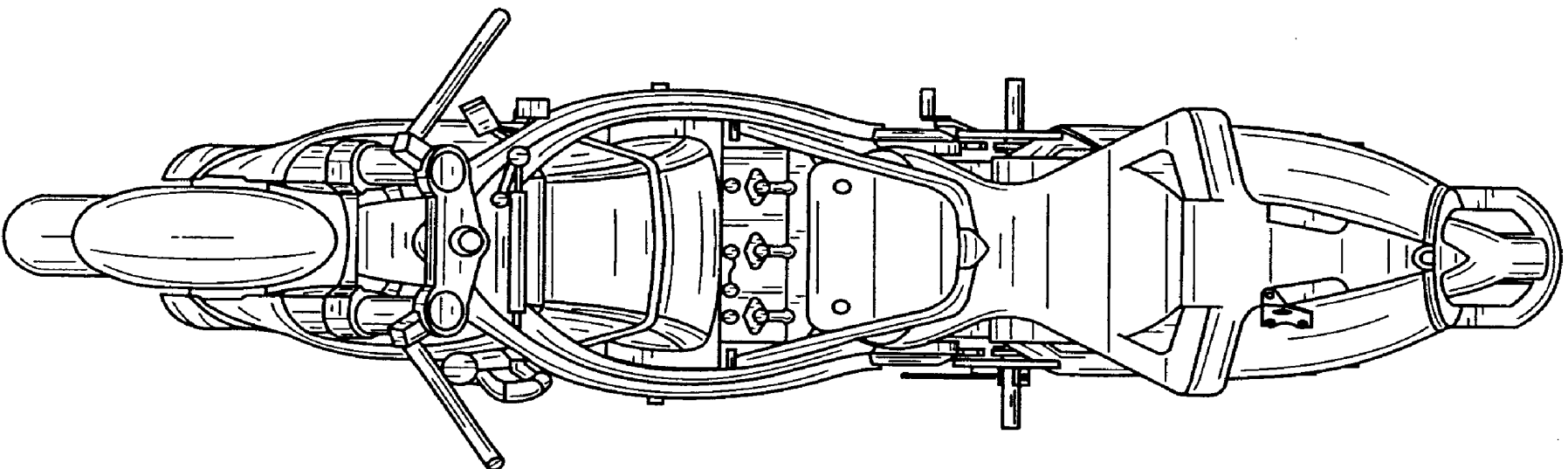

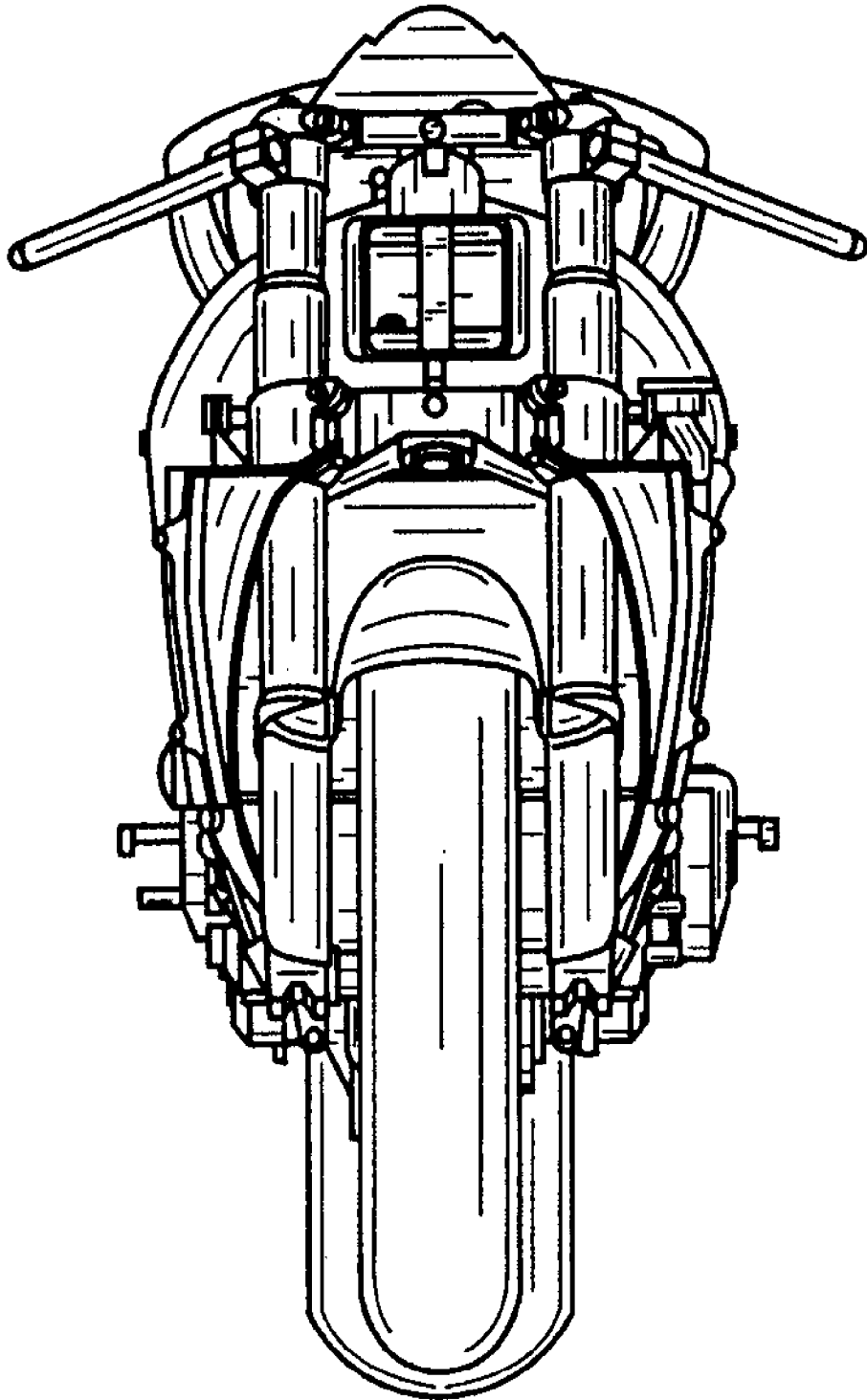

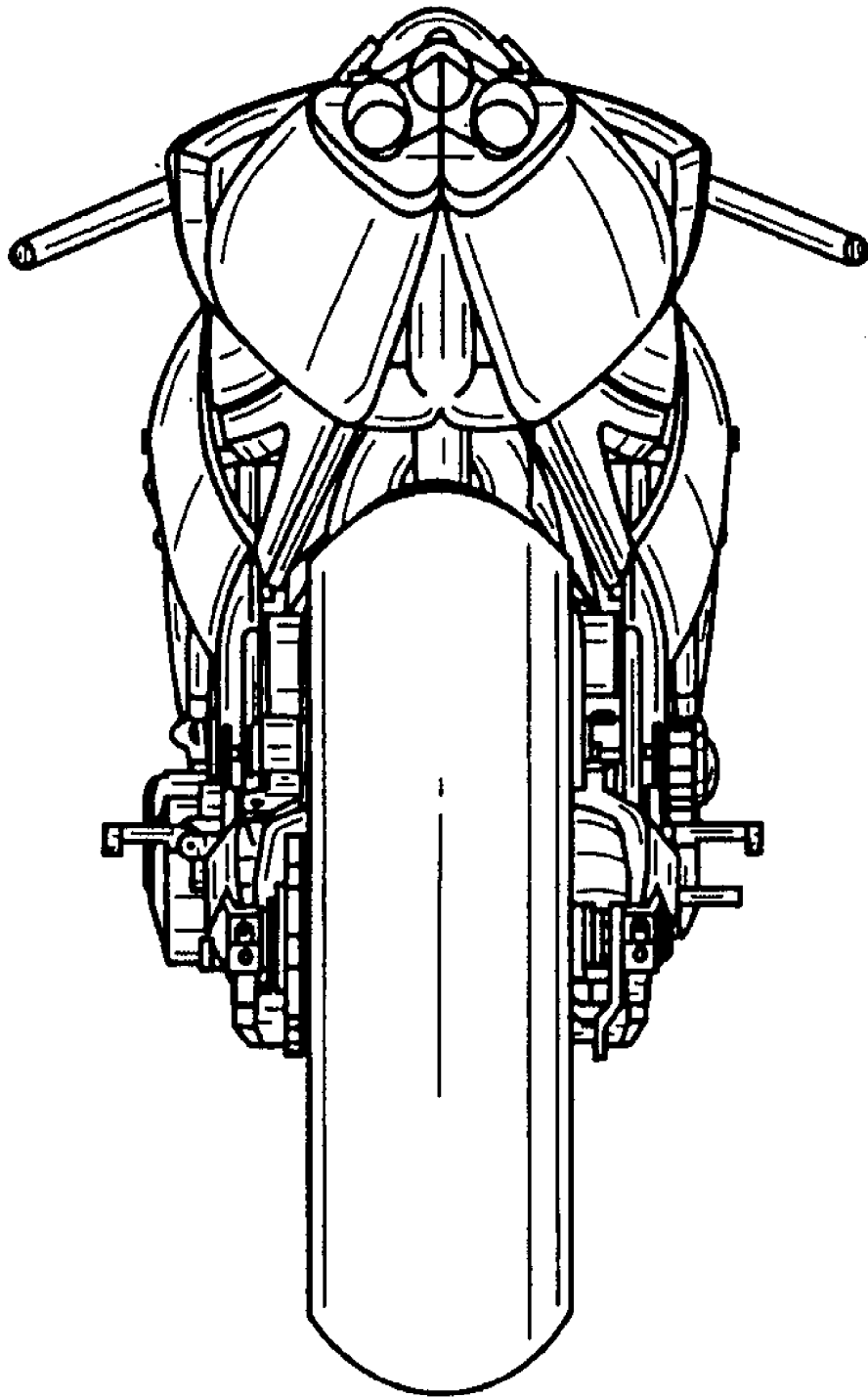

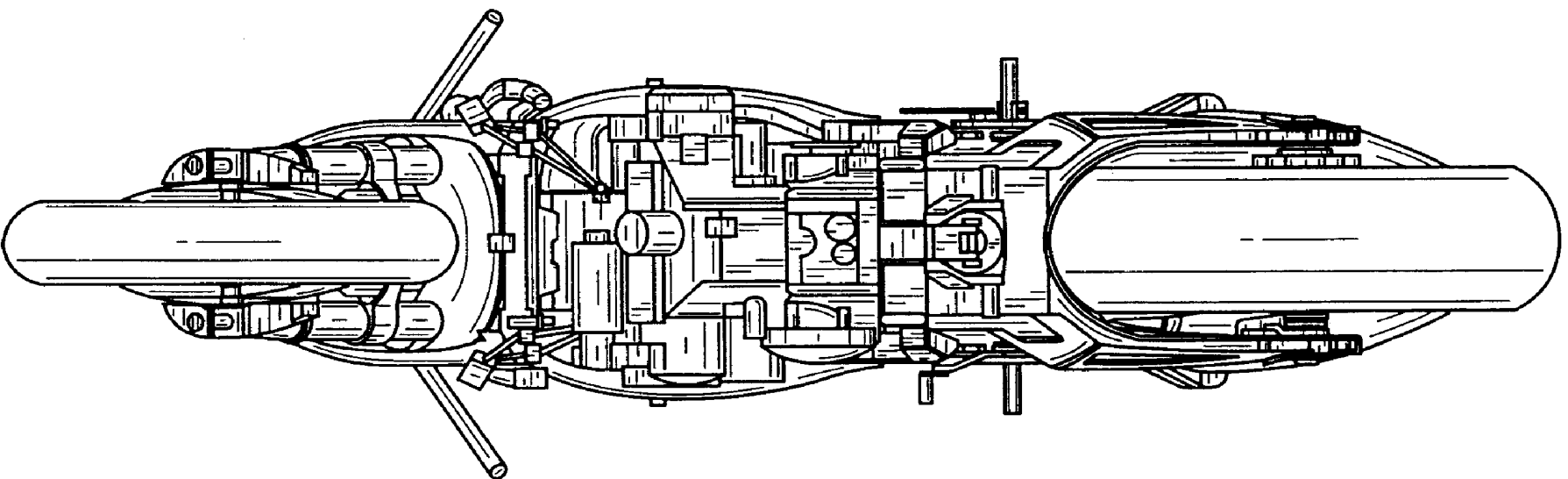

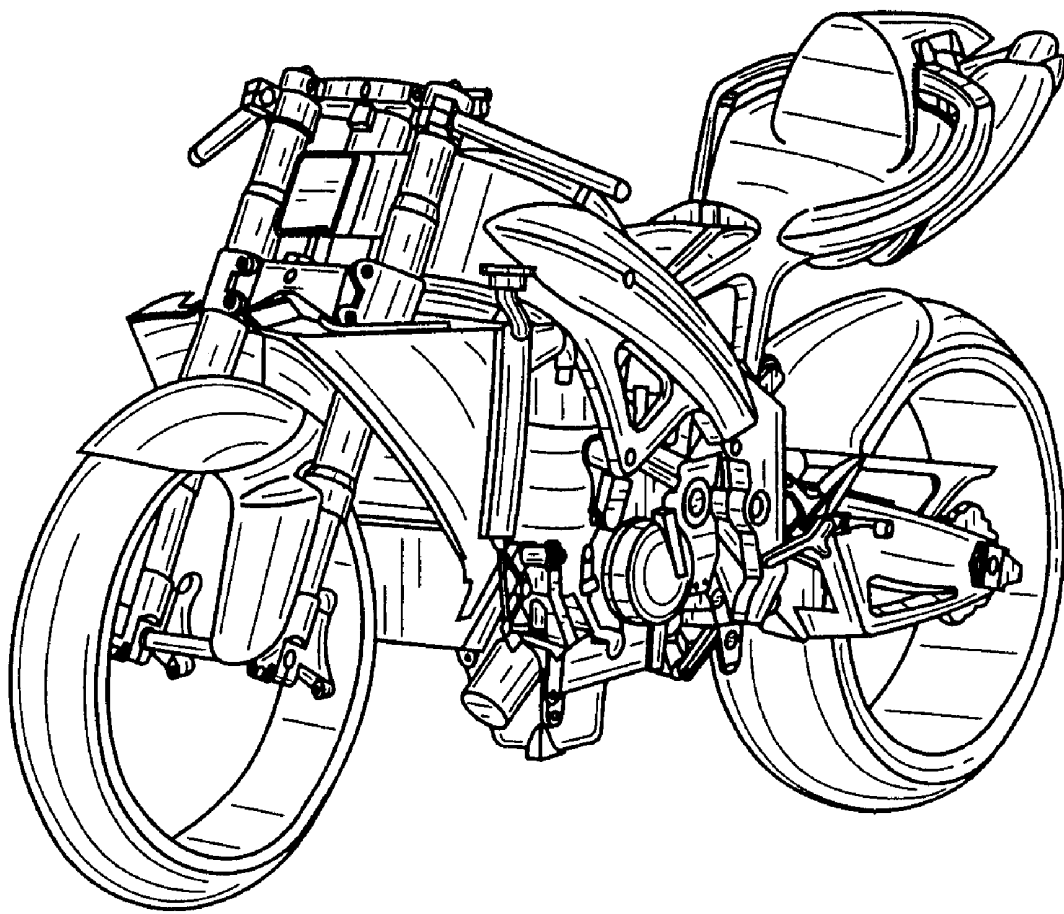
